#### CIS store works under the following fair trade principles:

Artisan groups work interactively and cooperatively. Artisans arepaid up front for goods, not on consignment enabling them to pay workers and have funds for inputs on new orders.

Artisans are paid a fair price for their crafs. CIS coordinates training workshops. Products, whenever possible, are made of local materials. Artisans stay actively involved in their local community, sharin g their values and benefits through various projects.

We sell fair trade products that are hand-made by Salvadoran artisans who have been profoundly committed to the community development.



Works with people from communities all over El Salvador to promote economic empowerment and independence.
